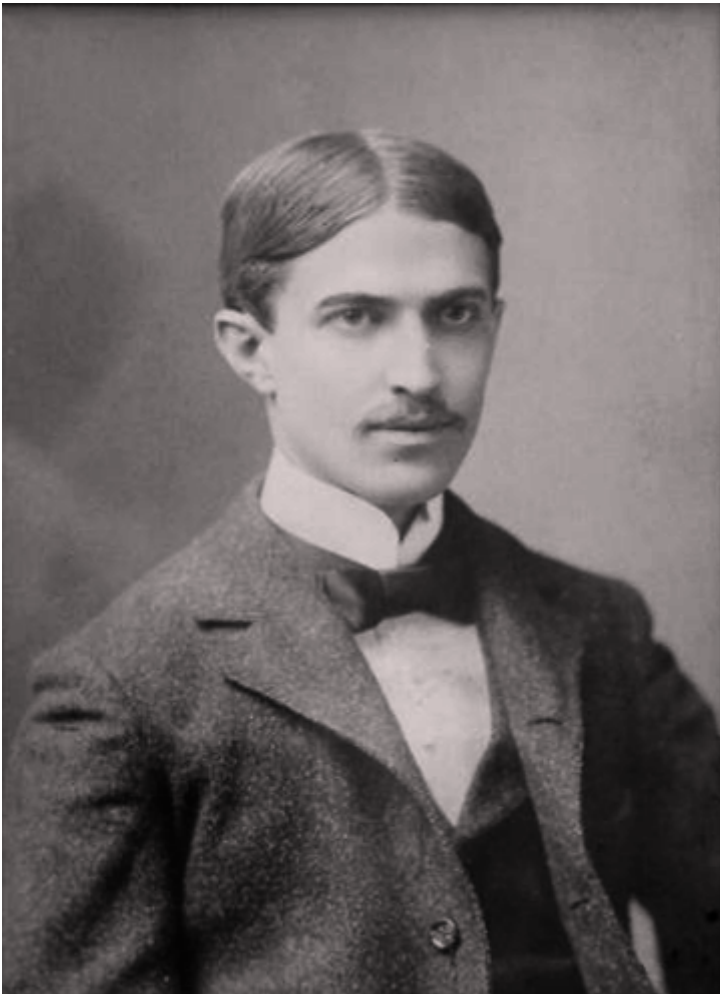
Poet Description:
